



OWL

crochet pattern



FINISHED SIZE

Owl is about 3.2 inches (8 cm).

MATERIALS

1. Yarn - the examples are crocheted using Alize Bella (100% cotton; 197 yards (180 meters) for 1.76 oz (50 g)). Yarn weight fine.
2. Crochet hook 1.75 mm (or in accordance with the yarn you use).
3. Polyester fiberfill stuffing (or similar).
4. Black thread (Yarn Art IRIS or other thin thread) for eyes.
5. Stitch marker.

TERMS USED

ch - chain (UK - chain)

sc - single crochet (UK - double crochet)

dc - double crochet (UK - treble crochet)

tr - triple crochet (UK - double treble crochet)

inc - 2 single crochet stitches in the same stitch (UK - increase in double crochet)

dec - 2 single crochet stitches together (UK - decrease in double crochet)

(...) - repeat what is inside () symbols the number of times specified in pattern

[...] - total amount of stitches in the round

fo - fasten off (UK - fasten off)

PATTERN

BODY

Start with gray yarn.

Round 1: 6 sc in a magic ring [6]

R2: (1 inc) x 6 [12]

R3: (1 sc, 1 inc) x 6 [18]

R4: (2 sc, 1 inc) x 6 [24]

R5: (3 sc, 1 inc) x 6 [30]

R6: (4 sc, 1 inc) x 6 [36]

R7 - R16: Sc around [36] - 10 rounds

Change to pink yarn.

R17 - R23: Sc around [36] - 7 rounds

R24: (4 sc, 1 dec) x 6 [30]

Fo. Cut the yarn leaving a tail for sewing.

Stuff the body firmly and sew it like on the photo.



EYES

Use white yarn

Round 1: 6 sc in a magic ring [6]

R2: (1 inc) x 6 [12]

R3: Sc around [12]

Fo. Cut the yarn leaving a tail for sewing.

Make 2.



Pupil of the eyes

Make magic ring and 6 sc in it. Sl st in the first sc. (use black thread Yarn Art IRIs or other and the crochet hook 1mm).

Make 2.



BEAK

Use yellow yarn.

Make a foundation chain with 3 ch.

Round 1: Starting in the 2nd chain from the hook: 2 sc [2]

R2: turn work around, 1 dec [1]

Fo. Cut the yarn leaving a tail for sewing.



WINGS

Use pink yarn

Left wing

Round 1: 6 sc in a magic ring [6]

R2: (1 inc) x 2, 2 hdc in next st, 2 dc in next st, 2 tr in next st.

Fo. Cut the yarn leaving a tail for sewing.



Right wing

Round 1: 6 sc in a magic ring [6]

R2: 4 ch, 1 tr in the same loop, 2 dc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, (1 inc) x 2

Fo. Cut the yarn leaving a tail for sewing.



FINISHING

Sew the eyes to the body after the 8th row.



Sew the beak and wings.



Make ears.

Put the yarn into the outer loop using the hook. Put the edges of the yarn into the formed loop and tighten it.



Your owl is ready!



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
